DAY 1

Land in Quito and orient yourself to Ecuador. At 9,350 feet, Quito sits in the beautiful Andes mountain range. You and your team will spend your first night in this vibrant city.

DAY 2

Explore local markets and cap off the evening with a salsa dancing cultural immersion class.

DAY 3

Today you'll get to explore the lush landscapes of Ecuador from the back of horse. Take a ride through the mountains and orient yourself to high altitude life. Travel south to the small town of Baños, known as a mystical destination at the foot of the Tungurahua volcano. Spend the night in Baños.

DAY 4

Explore the surrounding Quito area by enjoying the local Papallacta hot springs and experiencing the largest hummingbird sanctuary in the world.

Spend the afternoon at the Parque Aventura, Ecuador's very own adventure park. Cap the day off with some healthy competition as you and your group go head to head in a soccer tournament.

DAY 6-9

The next few days are going to be action packed! Fly to Santa Cruz and spend the days exploring the Highlands area. Snorkel the famous Concha de Peria, learn from the tortoise breeding center, try your hand at beach volleyball, hike through majestic volcanic geology, surf and visit Tortuga Bay - all in one region.

DAY 10-12

Visit Isla Lobos and Loberia for world class snorkeling.

Observe hundreds of species of fish in the crystal clear turquoise waters. You'll also get the opportunity to assist in an ecological conservation project. Then you'll get to enjoy a fresh lunch at the farm after your hard work and experience a local cooking class!



DAY 13-14

Travel from the Galapagos Islands back to Quito where you will celebrate all you've experienced with your group at a final banquet. Say goodbye to your new friends family, and to the incredible places you've come to know in Ecuador and the Galapagos as you fly with your group back to the United States.
