


EXPERIENCE HIGHLIGHTS

Spend six days hiking and camping across the island of Madeira, up and over volcanic peaks and narrow valleys

Dip into the refreshing waters of the Ecological Park of Funchal as you wade, rappel, jump, slide, and swim your way through the laurel forests on a canyoneering adventure

Scale and scurry up the jagged, volcanic rocks on this climbing adventure of the easternmost point called Baia D'Abra

Surf's up as you ride the tides of the bluest, clearest, and most pristine ocean water you've ever seen that gently collides with the softest, warmest, black volcanic sand beaches

Channel your inner child for the wildest activity of all - coasteering! A maritime merry-go-round, coasteering includes swimming, climbing, and jumping along the coast

DAY 1-2

You will be picked up at the Madeira Airport and driven to the wonderful quaint town of Porto Muniz where you will take a refreshing dip in the Porto Moniz Natural Swimming Pools

DAY 3-8

Spend the next six days trekking across the island of Madeira. You'll weave in and out of different mountains, valleys, forests, and clouds with sweeping views of the entire island. You'll even venture up Pico Ruivo, the tallest peak on all of Madeira.

DAY 9

Now that you've connected with the land, it's time to cool off and try your hand at canyoneering! With harnesses, ropes, and belay systems, you'll learn to rappel waterfalls, jump into pool, and slide down rock formations.

DAY 10

Take those canyoneering skills and trade them in for rock climbing! You'll be familiar with most of the gear, so now all you have to do is start the vertical climb! Reward yourself with a dip in the Atlantic Ocean!

DAY 11

Now it's time to island hop! Take a ferry over to the small, quaint island of Porto Santo where the adventure doesn't stop!

DAY 15


All aboard for a whale and dolphin watch tour of a lifetime!
